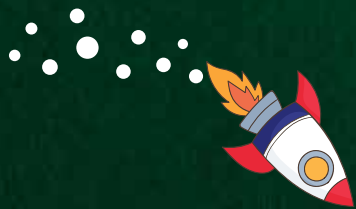
STORY TELLING

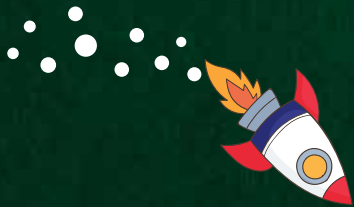
SHOW & TELL COMPETITION

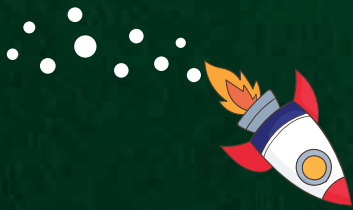
ENSURING HEALTH AND HYGIENE

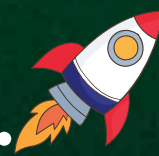


PARENT TEACHER MEETING

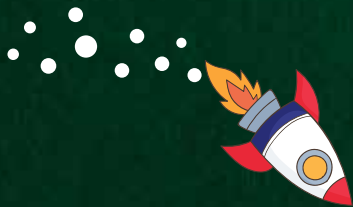
CONTINUOUS PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT OF TEACHERS

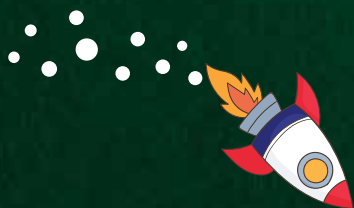
CLASS ROOM MANAGEMENT WORKSHOP
